From your Course Home page, click Grades in the Administration block.

Notice the addition of tabs for easier navigation. We also kept the dropdown menu.

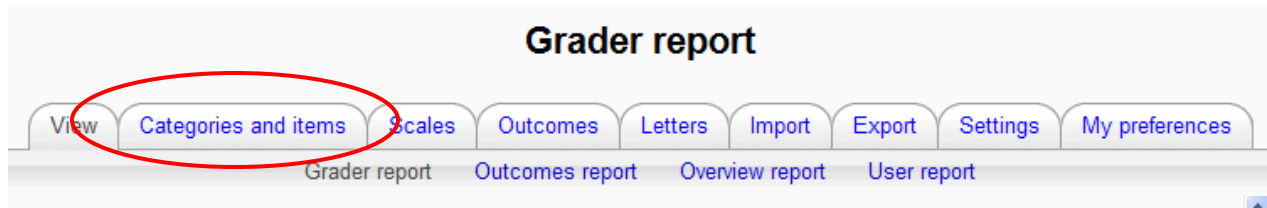
